## Remembering Our Own (half day)



Discover WWI through the eyes of a Bruce County soldier. Students will get hands-on with a special selection of artifacts and archival material to discover what life was like at the front and for those left at home. ## Anishnaabwe Endaat (half day)



Students will learn about Indigenous ways of knowing and learning and connecting to the land through storytelling, discussion, games and art creation as featured in our newest permanent gallery.

## The Great Outdoors (half day)



Come learn on the Fairy Lake trail from the greatest teacher of all: Mother Nature. This program can be catered to most grades' Understanding Life Systems strands and is popular in the spring so book early!

## The Last Frontier (half day)



Discover the Bruce County's history from the 1850s-1900s. Students will learn what life was like for different groups of people at this time through maps, artifacts, crafts, games, and galleries. Explore the changing landscape, pioneer technology, and the role of the general store.

## NEW! "Scene" the Bruce? (full day)



Explore historical fiction and act out your knowledge. Classes will focus on the elements of a story as they do a tour of the exhibits then write and star in their own short skits at the end of the day using the exhibits as their sets.
