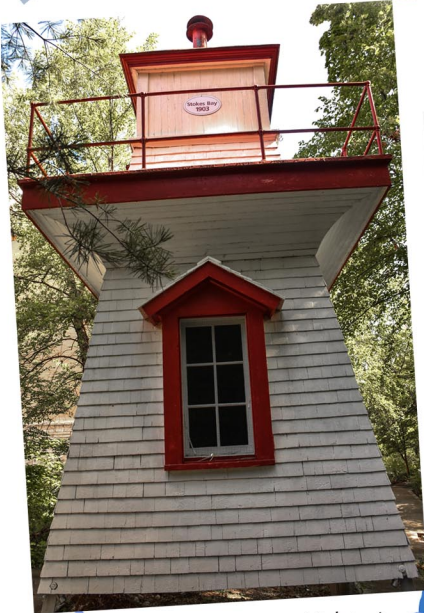

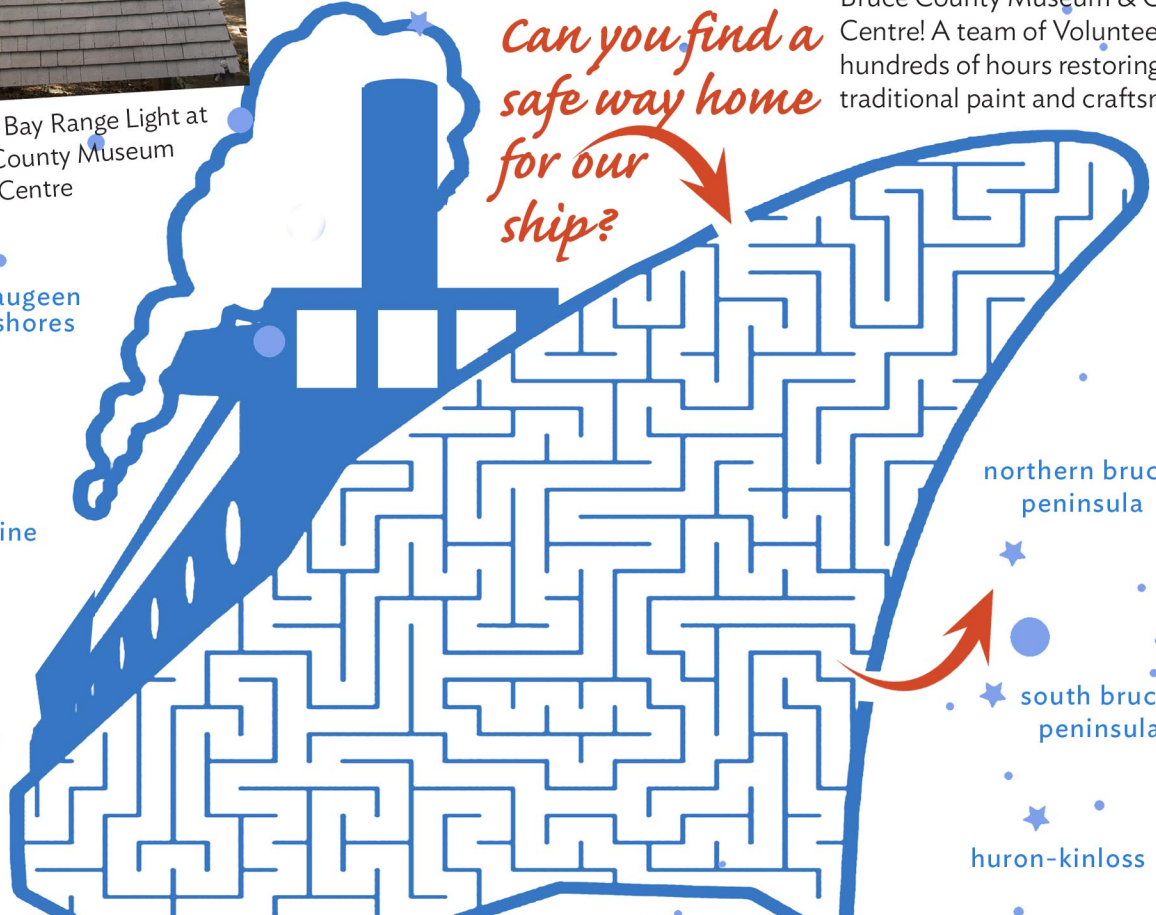
The Stokes Bay Range Light at the Bruce County Museum & Cultural Centre

In 1904, a pair of range lights were erected in **Stokes Bay** to help guide vessels between Lyal Island and Mad Reef, replacing a pair of day beacons in the Municipality of **Northern Bruce Peninsula**. In December 2009 the larger light was decommissioned by the Canadian Coast Guard and moved to the Bruce County Museum & Cultural Centre! A team of Volunteers spent hundreds of hours restoring it using traditional paint and craftsmanship.
